QUICKSTART TEAM TENNIS

Players: Participants must be 4 – 6 years old during participation in the league.

Parents: Parent involvement is necessary. Parents will assist to make sure the kids keep score correctly and are calling fair lines. Emphasis will be on sportsmanship first, not winning. No matches will be played without parent monitors.

Teams, Practice, Match: Teams will be formed by Harrison Tennis Center's teaching professionals. Each team will have a 45 minute lesson for four weeks. Weeks five & six will be team matches. A team match consists of 3 singles positions, called "A", "B", and "C" singles. Boys and girls will compete together.

Scoring: Format will be best of three games. Each game will be to seven points. The server will call out the score before each point.

Service: Points can be started with an overhead serve, or underhand serve. If the player double-faults, the parent or coach will toss the ball to start the point.

The undersigned hereby forever releases, discharges, and covenants to hold harmless the Cobb County Parks, Recreation and Cultural Affairs Department, the Cobb County Recreation Commission, the Cobb Arts Commission, the Cobb County Board of Commissioners and Cobb County, Georgia and any other person, firm, corporation charged or chargeable with responsibility or liability, their heirs, administrators, executors, successors and assigns from any and all claims, demands, damages, costs, expenses, loss of services, actions and causes of action belonging to the undersigned or arising out of any act or occurrence in connection with and particularly on account of all personal injury, disability, property damage, loss or damages of any kind sustained or that may hereafter be sustained arising out of the matters described herein or in consequence of the participation in the recreation program sponsored by the Cobb County parks, Recreation and Cultural Affairs department. The undersigned hereby bind their heirs, administrators, executors and successors. Further, this agreement shall apply to all unknown and unanticipated injuries and damages directly or indirectly resulting here-from. This Release and Hold Harmless Agreement shall constitute a full and complete release of any and all claims.

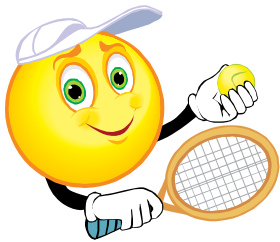

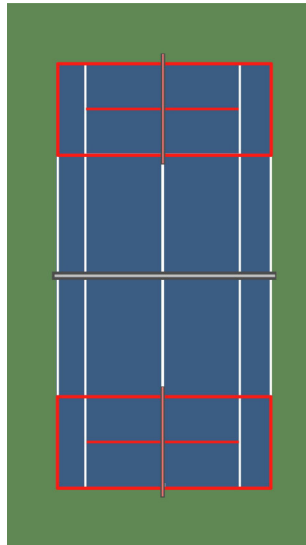

THE MINI TENNIS COURT

In 2007, Harrison Tennis Center was selected as a pilot program site for QuickStart Team Tennis and in 2008, Cobb County, along with supporting grants and sponsorships from USTA, ALTA, and other organizations and businesses, built the first USTA-approved 36' QuickStart tennis courts in the country here at Harrison Tennis Center.

There are 6 six courts. Each court is 36' long and 18' wide. The base lines are the original court's double lines. The net is 2' 9" high. Two courts are created on the original full size court.
